ADELAIDE SIGHTSEEING – BAROSSA VALLEY WINE TOUR

Our tour begins meandering through the Torrens Gorge, passing through Kangaroo Creek Reservoir and Millbrooke Reservoir and through Williamstown where you will see the beautiful stone buildings. About mid morning you will be greeted with the aroma of fresh coffee at one of the local bakeries, for an authentic German Bienenstich cake. The road continues through the valley passing picturesque vineyards and quaint villages displaying the old world charm of the pioneering days. The Barossa Valley is renowned for dried fruits and confectionery so a visit to Angas Park Fruits in the township of Angaston is a must. From Mengler's Hill Lookout, you

will have a magnificent view of the entire valley of vines and quaint villages such as Bethany, Tanunda and Angaston. Then it's off to lunch where you will enjoy a 2 course lunch with complimentary tea/coffee and a chance to do some wine tasting as well. Another opportunity to taste premium wines at the "Jacobs Creek Visitor Centre" and here you will learn about viticulture and wine production. Another great winery stop where you will have the opportunity to taste and select fine wines and experience some local hospitality. On the way back to Adelaide we stop at the Whispering Wall to discover it's secrets.
