Kakadu, Nourlangie Rock And Yellow Water

Depart Darwin and enter Kakadu National Park, Australia's largest and arguably most famous national park. Visit Warradjan Aboriginal Cultural Centre before joining a guided cruise along Kakadu's most famous wetland area, Yellow Water Billabong, keeping an eye out for the regions abundant wildlife, including crocodiles. After lunch, take a guided tour to Nourlangie Rock to see well-preserved galleries of Aboriginal rock art. On the return trip to Darwin, stop at Windows on the Wetland for a glass of wine as you watch the changing light of day over the floodplains.

Litchfield National Park

Litchfield National Park is one of the Northern Territory's newest national parks, with 146,000 virtually untouched hectares waiting to be explored. View Florence Falls from a lookout positioned high above the falls. Continue to Tolmer Falls, where you can take a short walk to be rewarded with spectacular views of the falls. From here, venture to Wangi Falls for a picnic lunch. There is a natural waterhole, where you have time to relax and swim if you wish (conditions permitting).
