Highlights Of Alice Springs

Originally settled as a post along the Overland Telegraph route, Alice Springs today is a lively town full of things to see and places to go. Visit the base of the Royal Flying Doctor service and the School of the Air, two uniquely Australian organisations that provide medical care and education respectively to people in remote areas of central Australia. Enjoy panoramic views of the town and the rugged MacDonnell Ranges from Anzac Hill. Stop for a visit to the Alice Springs Telegraph Station before being dropped back to your hotel.

Outback Ballooning

Float gently into the air as the morning sun lights up the MacDonnell Ranges, and Central Australia awakens for a new day. Wildlife, particularly big red kangaroos are seen nearly every day as the balloon crosses spinifex grasses, mulga scrub and cattle stations. Be sure to take your camera to capture the brilliant views before you.

After landing we will then break open the champagne and tropical fruit juice to celebrate your flight. This will be accompanied by a selection of muesli biscuits, exotic slices, cheese and fresh fruit in the silent remote bush where you landed. You will also have the opportunity to purchase photographs taken earlier in the morning.

3 Day Central Rock And Canyon

Travel from modern-day Alice Springs to ancient Uluru, stopping along at an Outback Camel Farm. Continue onto Yulara, permanent campsite for lunch and time to explore Uluru. At Sunset witness the rock's chameleon hues while sipping a cold glass of bubbles. Day 2 a truly special experience as daylight breaks over Kata Tjuta. Travelling through red sand dunes to Kings Creek Station our campsite for tonight. Try a traditional camp oven dinner and marvel at the brilliant star studded desert sky. Day 3 discover the Lost City and the Garden of Eden on a 7km hike followed by a well earned swim in a nearby rockpool.

The photo opportunities are endless so be sure to bring a camera.
