Walpa Gorge, Uluru Sunset & Barbeque Tour

Travel to the mystical 36 domes of Kata Tjuta. Stop for panoramic views of the south side of Kata Tjuta. Continue on to the base of Walpa Gorge. Spend time exploring the unusual conglomerate rock formations. The walking trail follows the natural creek between two of the tallest domes of Kata Tjuta. In the late afternoon we travel to Uluru sunset viewing area. Witness and photograph the striking colour changes of Uluru at Sunset, enjoying nibbles and a glass of wine. Enjoy a barbecue at an exclusive venue.

Uluru, Kings Canyon And Alice Springs

Arrive into Ayers Rock, spending the afternoon at the cultural Centre and Maruku Arts and Craft cooperative. Join a guided walk to the waterhole of Mutijulu waterhole followed by a guided Mala walk. Enjoy a glass of wine as you admire the changing colours of Uluru as the sun slowly sinks into the desert plain. Rise early to see Uluru sunrise today will be spent in Kata Tjuta before arriving into Kings Canyon. Enjoy a guided walk around the rim of Kings Canyon with spectacular views of the canyon's walls. Walk through the ancient Lost City and the lush Garden of Eden, gentler options are available. After lunch we travel to Alice Springs.
